Program Structure and Expectations

The Maroon Academy for Teaching Excellence consists of four asynchronous, online courses. Participants should expect to engage in coursework for several hours each week. In addition to the online modules, participants are required to implement selected teaching strategies during the following fall semester.

Fall Semester Implementation

During the fall semester, participants will document the application of these strategies in their course(s). The implementation phase concludes in December with the submission of both an Implementation Report and a Course Reflection.

Completion Requirements

All program components including weekly coursework, fall-semester implementation activities, and final submissions must be successfully completed to earn the certification and to be eligible for the associated stipend payment.

Faculty will be compensated for finishing course 1 (\$250) and course 2 (\$500) at the conclusion of the semester of implementation. Furthermore, in the second year, they will receive compensation for completing course 3 (\$750) and course 4 (\$1000) after the conclusion of the semester of implementation.
